- Promoted Plant Sale
- Very Cold attendance died down at sunset

### Plant Sale Recap;

Gross Sales: \$2,507

• Costs: \$1,079 (incomplete, volunteer purchases unaccounted)

Plant Sales Total: \$1,790 (vs 2023: \$1,344)

- Merch Sales Total: \$444 (costs included above)
- Donations/Keep the Change: \$273

Net Sales: \$1,428.00 (vs 2023 Net: \$930)

What did we learn? What would we do differently?

- Press and Marketing
  - Social media good 5 weeks of posts
  - Press coverage good front page RW and DC
  - Graphics and flyers had 30, seemed good, find a way to share through churches
  - FA&B booth good- hit with a dozen or more people
  - Printing Use Associated Printing
    - Laminated Images were very helpful, and reusable
      - \$3 a page at Associated Printing
    - 2 Step In Signs
      - \$25 each at Associated Printing
    - Print way more than 40 companion sheets (ran out by 11)
      - Maybe don't give to everyone but make available
  - Plant Planning
    - Grow more of: flowers in color, dwarf sunflowers, squash, cucumbers, zucchini, basil, yarrow
    - Grow less of: *yacon, parsley,*
    - Just right amount: <u>tomatoes, peppers</u>
    - Cut out 6 packs, streamline more 3"- 4" pots

  - Plant Sourcing \_
    - Buying Plugs receive order 4 weeks from sale, no more
  - Growing (Congratulations!)
    - 3 week grow out from transplant to sale (ordering target)
    - Have frost protection in place
  - Materials
    - More tags, better communicate how to tag, make sure all are tagged ahead of time
    - Box carrier collection had way more than enough
    - Can trays from food pantry is enough, stick to that weeks before
    - Take surveys of how they heard about Plant Sale
  - Kids Activity Station
    - Try coloring books and sidewalk chalk, not pot up station

- Setting Up
  - 2 loads came to the clubhouse, rest held Fri PM in vehicles
  - 1 truck, 2 carloads from clubhouse to garden Sat AM
  - 5 loads directly from homes to garden Sat AM
    - (8 total vehicles needed Sat AM)
  - DO NOT START SALES UNTIL START TIME
    - If changing start time, allow 2.5 hours of loading, moving and setting up before
  - Have a "Free advice (with donation) booth"
- Budget/Inputs

  - Volunteer Growing Time not accounted
